The Society was founded in 1973, its objectives being:

- Generally to encourage high standards of quality in the built environment.

The Society monitors planning applications submitted to the City Corporation and makes comments about them which are a significant factor in the Corporation's decision making.

The Society arranges social and educational events including lectures, visits and walks. The Society's Annual Dinner is a notable occasion in the City's calendar.

Each year since 1978 the Society, in conjunction with the Worshipful Company of Painter-Stainers, presents the City Heritage Award for what is considered to be the best refurbishment project in the City of London.
